Page 1 - Panel 1 - 1/2 of Page

Panel Layout: Establishing shot of the universe. Doesn't have to be too detailed, but enough to know it's our universe.

NARRATION: Our universe

NARRATION: History has shown us its many complexities and simplicities alike

Page 1 - Panel 2 - 1/2 of Page

Panel Layout: This view is as if you are hiding in the jungle, looking from the inside looking out. What we see through the jungle is a not-so-distinct shot of the back of a T-Rex that appears to have something in its mouth.

NARRATION: And from these we're given the laws of nature

NARRATION: Laws that are universal

NARRATION: Laws that apply to all forms of life

NARRATION: The first and by far the most important law being....

Page 2 - Panel 1 - 1/6 Size of Page

Panel Layout: A medium-off-center shot of a T-Rex mauling a lone raptor. Make sure that the dominance of the T-Rex is represented in this panel.

NARRATION: (BOLD) ...Survival of the fittest!!!

Page 2 - Panel 2 - 1/8 Size of Page

Panel Layout: Same type of panel as the first on this page, only with a lion and a hyena instead.

NARRATION: But just as the first law provides the most powerful with a sense of dominance...

Page 2 - Panel 3 - Whatever's left of Page

Panel Layout: Another panel of the same type as the last two. This one though should be a tight shot of a huge insect dominating a single ant.

NARRATION: Nature gives us yet another of its laws

Page 3 - Panel 1 - 1/6 of Page

Panel Layout: This is a follow up to the T-Rex panel on the second page. Only in this one, the view pans out to see a group of raptors starting to surround the T-Rex

NARRATION: A law that proves that there is a natural balance

Page 3 - Panel 2 - 1/8 of Page

Panel Layout: Another follow up. This time, for the lion. This is the same type of panel as the first panel of this page but only with a pack of hyena instead of raptors.

NARRATION: A balance that allows all forms of life to dominate

Page 3 - Panel 3 - Whatever's left of Page

Panel Layout: Worms-eye view. Another follow up. This time, for the huge insect. This is the same type of panel as the first panel of this page but only with an army of ants instead of hyena.

NARRATION: That law?

Page 4 - Panel 1 - Full Page (Splash)

Layout: O.K. This panel should really do it for the reader. The bottom left-hand corner should contain the exact same scene as the last panel of page 3. The rest of the panel contains about three larger figures outnumbered by about ten smaller figures. The three figs. should be grouped tightly together as if in formation to defend themselves. Of the three figs., the your main focus(meaning who you should make look the coolest), should be on the "older, wiser and more distinc" one in the middle of the other two. He is the current Chief of the Shadow Clan Wolf, "Chief Black Wolf" (I know - How Original, Huh? Doesn't matter, he dies anyway!). Their backs are turned to us at a worm's-eye 3/4 view so that we see what kind of odds they're up against. They dressed in tribal gear and are weaponless, but look very confident considering thier situation. The other ten or so figs. should look ready to pound at any minute. They are wearing a certain kind of stealth suit(kinda like the suit Snake Eyes from G.I. Joe has), but their faces can be seen. One of them(who in future books is revealed to be "Stripes" of the Swarm Clan Insect), should be on the frontline and seem like the dominant one of them all. One of his hands is extended and is pointing out towards his enemies. The other hand is holding a halberd(a sort of spear with the blade of a short sword). The other figs. in his group also have close-combat weapons of all sorts and sizes. It's gonna get ugly, FAST!!

Page 5 - Panel 1 - 1/3 of Page

Panel Layout: Medium shot of Stripes' full bust. His face looks very devilish. We can see a few of the other figs. that are with him in the background. They look just as vicious.

STRIPES: (STILL YELLING) The end of the Clans of Old starts today old man!

STRIPES: Mr. Emerald has sent us to take back what is rightfully his.

Page 5 - Panel 2 - 1/3 of Page

Panel Layout: Opposite of the first panel, this one is a tight shot of the full busts of the three clan members. Black Wolf should be in the forefront. Now that we see their faces, we see that Black Wolf is an older looking man, but his eyes clearly show that he is the leader(HE IS PISSED!). The other two look just as mad. We can faintly see their enemies closing in around them.
